



World food prices hit record high in 2022

Food and Agriculture Organization's (FAO) Food Price Index continued to drop in December, however, it rose substantially on a yearly basis. The FAO food price index, which tracks international prices of the most globally traded food commodities, averaged 143.7 points in 2022, up 14.3% from 2021, and the highest since records started in 1990, the agency said on January 6, 2023.
